

\$50,000 Sunset Moulding-Yuba City Racquet Club Men's Challenger

Doubles wildcard awarded for upcoming USTA Men's Pro Circuit Challenger in Yuba City.

Yuba City, CA—May 29, 2008— The Yuba City Racquet Club awarded a main draw doubles wild card entry to Jan-Michael Gambill, USA and Scott Oudsema, USA. Gambill has 32 Grand Slam appearances including 19 as a doubles player and a career high doubles ranking of #23 in 2002. Gambill earned five career titles for doubles with wins in San Jose, CA(w/ Scott Humphries) and Delray Beach, FL (w, Andy Roddick), ATP Masters Series in Hamburg, Germany (w/ Mahesh Bhupathi), Hong Kong (w/ Graydon Oliver) and his last tour title in 2003 in Los Angeles (w/ Travis Parrott). Gambill's career wins include Roger Federer, Carlos Moyà, Mark Philippoussis, Lleyton Hewitt, Pete Sampras, and Andre Agassi.

Scott Oudsema, USA currently ranked #257 in doubles with a career high doubles ranking of #151 in 2007 will partner with Jan Michael Gambill. In 2008, Oudsema reached the semifinals at the Tunica Challenger with Bobby Reynolds. Oudsema has two USTA Futures doubles championships at Irvine, CA and Waikoloa, HI. As a junior, Oudsema reached the finals at the USTA Boys' 18's in both singles and doubles. Oudsema's junior tennis highlights include winning three of the four Grand Slam Junior doubles titles with Brendan Evan, USA (Australian Open, Wimbledon, US Open). He and Evans also reached the junior doubles semifinals at Roland Garros in 2004.

In addition, the Yuba City Racquet Club announced that a second main draw singles wildcard was awarded to Dejan Djokic, SRB. Djokic competed in the Yuba City Challenger in 2006 and 2007.

With 94 tournaments throughout the country and prize money ranging from \$10,000 to \$100,000, the USTA Pro Circuit is the pathway to the US Open and tour-level competition for aspiring tennis players and a frequent battleground for established professionals. Last year, more than 1,000 men and women from more than 70 countries competed on the USTA Pro Circuit for approximately \$3.2 million in prize money and valuable ATP and WTA Tour ranking points. Maria Sharapova, Andy Roddick, James Blake, Justine Henin, Nicole Pietrangeli, Andy Murray, David Nalbandian and Jo-Wilfried Tsonga are among today's top stars who began their careers on the USTA Pro Circuit. The USTA Pro Circuit is world-class tennis administered on the local level and played on local tennis courts as part of the fabric of communities nationwide—an opportunity for current and new fans to experience the excitement and intensity of the professional game in their neighborhood.
